2018 Klondike Derby Event Information (Cont.)

PATROL SIZE	Minimum of 4, maximum of 8 Scouts per patrol
KLONDIKE SLED	All patrols must have a sled to compete. Webelos & Arrow of Light Scouts can use a manufactured sled to carry supplies. Troops & Crews sleds must be home made and be between 4 feet and 6.5 feet long and 21-26 inches wide. Wheels & commercial skis are NOT permitted. The sled must be able to hold 1 Scout and all your equipment.
NO SNOW?	If there is no snow & the ground is soft, BE PREPARED to carry your equipment in backpacks from station to station. If there is no snow, wheels are allowed to prevent sled damage.
CANCELLATION	The event will run snow, rain, or shine.
LUNCH	Lunch will be provided for all registered youth & adult participants.
WATER	Bring whatever water is needed for your own use. Limited water is available.
LATRINES	Heated toilets are available near the main parking lot.
UNIFORM	The Boy Scouts of America is a uniformed organization and uniforms should be worn by all participants.
WARM CLOTHING	Any one wearing "tennis shoes" WILL NOT be permitted to participate. Patrol leaders are responsible for proper winter apparel for their youth. DRESS FOR THE WEATHER!
FIRST AID	Each patrol is to have a First Aid kit for minor injuries. Major injuries will be handled by camp medical staff. Units should bring a signed parental release form to the derby.
