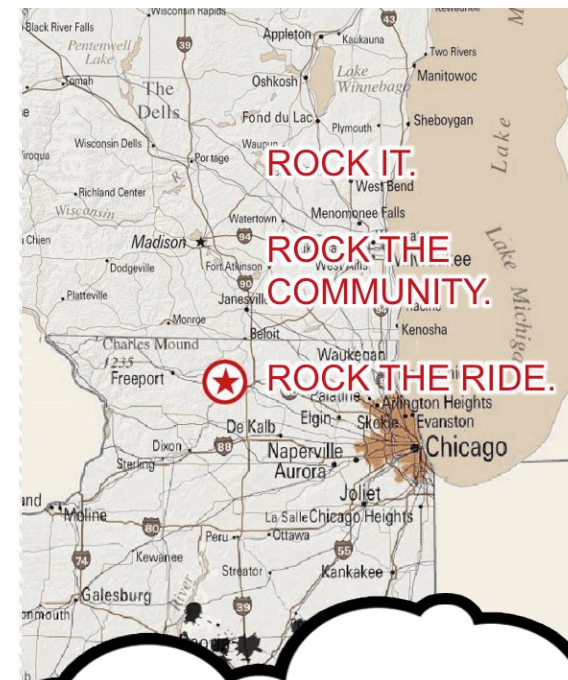

HAVE A BLAST at the 2016 Camporee!

This outdoor event for Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturers, Explorers, their families and leaders is expected to bring thousands of participants from Illinois and Wisconsin to Rockford for bicycling, service projects, activities and more. Camping is available Friday and Saturday nights for Webelos Scouts and older, while younger scouts are invited to spend the day Saturday participating in activities planned just for them!

WHO: All registered Scouts, their families and leaders.

WHEN: Friday, Sept. 30, through Sunday, Oct. 2. Day passes are available for Saturday.

WHERE: Midway Village grounds, 6799 Guilford Rd., Rockford, IL. Boy Scout-age and older units are invited to bring their bikes to ride Midway Village's 1.5-mile paved trail as well as 5 miles along the Perryville Path bike trail to Rock Cut State Park and on the 30 miles of bike/mountain bike trails within the park. Bikes will be supplied to Cub Scouts to ride the 1.5-mile trail in Midway Village.



Overnight Camping

Camping overnight is available for Boy Scouts, Venturers and Explorers. Webelos Dens may also camp with a Boy Scout Troop. Units will camp in Jamboree-style sites, with scouts from Blackhawk Area Council and beyond intermingled in each sub-camp. Venture Crews will have a separate sub-camp. Grill and camp-stove cooking will be allowed on site, but campfires are not.
