Dear Pack Day Camp Coordinator,

It is a pleasure to welcome you to our 2018 White Eagle Cub Scout Day Camp at Camp Lowden! In this packet, you will find the following items (please print out as needed for your pack):

ADULT VOLUNTEERS

To provide the best possible day camp experience, we need each pack to provide the following volunteers:

- Den Walkers: Each pack should provide a minimum of one Den Walker for every seven Scouts at camp each day, although we recommend one walker for every five Scouts. Remember to maintain two deep leadership. Lions/Tigers need to have an adult partner for EACH Scout. Den Walkers will travel from station to station with their den, providing assistance wherever needed.
- **Den Guide:** The Den Guide is responsible for making sure each Scout from their pack is signed in and out each day. They will also need to distribute camp shirts and name tags. Den Guides should plan to arrive at camp by 8:15 am each day to pick up the pack's clip board, sign in sheet, and shirts. They will need to stay at the end of the day until everyone from their pack is picked up/signed out. No Den Guide is needed for Lion/Tiger Day as they will sign in and out at Camp Headquarters. The same person may be a Den Guide and Walker.
- **Program Staff:** Each pack needs to provide one program staff member each day Tuesday through Friday (although they may also volunteer on Monday if they wish). Program Staff will remain in one area for the entire day and lead that activity for up to seven periods. All programs are planned; all materials and training are provided. Program staff should plan to arrive a little early to set up their area and stay a little late to clean up. They will also need to attend one training session. Program staff that volunteer for two or more days get a free shirt.

Thank you for entrusting your Scout to us for Cub Scout Day Camp. Day camp is often the highlight of the summer Cub Scout program, designed to engage the interests and meet the needs of Cub Scout aged children. Activities at our camp include crafts, games, archery, BB guns, nature, Scout skills, and much more, all under the supervision of certified leadership and a dedicated and qualified staff.

Day Camp Dates (based on rank in fall 2018):

- Lion and Tiger Day (all Scouts must have an adult 18 or over with them at camp): Monday, July 30
- Wolf and Bear: Tuesday, July 31 and Wednesday, August 1
- Webelos and Arrow or Light:
 Thursday, August 2 and Friday, August 3
- Webelos/AOL Overnight (this is optional):
 Friday, August 3-Saturday Morning.

Day Camp Schedule:

Registration/Check-In: 8:30-9:00 am

Opening Ceremony and Activities Begin: 9:00 am

Closing: 4:00 pm (2:30 pm for Lion and Tiger Day)

Camp Attire:

The camp uniform is the official camp t-shirt, which is worn each day of camp. Campers may choose to wear shorts or pants. For safety reasons, ALL campers and staff must wear closed toed shoes or boots and socks.

Registration:

Please register your Scout according to their rank in the fall of 2018. Your Pack Day Camp Coordinator can collect your registration forms and fees, or you may register and pay for your Scout online using the Doubleknot calendar at www.blackhawkscouting.org.

Camp fees are \$35 per Scout (\$20 for Lions/Tigers) if received by June 15, after which there is a \$10 late fee. No registrations will be accepted after June 22. Registrations include a T-shirt, patch, water bottle, and memories to last a lifetime. Adults attending camp are required to purchase a camp T-shirt for \$7 (\$9 for 2XL-3XL). Only campers and adults that are registered for camp are allowed to attend and only on the days for which they are registered.

ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS FOR CAMP WILL BE GIVEN. CAMP FEES ARE TRANSFERRABLE FROM ONE SCOUT TO ANOTHER FOR THIS EVENT ONLY.

Transportation:

Parents bring Scouts to camp each day. Carpooling is encouraged. However, Scouts will only be released to adults designated in the Annual Health and Medical Record as authorized to take Scouts from events. Please be sure to specify all adults who will be transporting Scouts on the medical form. The adult responsible for drop off and pick up will also need to sign the Scout in and out each day.

It is important to drop off and pick up Scouts on time to allow camp to run smoothly. Scouts who are dropped off late or need to be picked up early will need to be dropped off/picked up at Camp Headquarters. Please contact the Camp Director to make the necessary arrangements.

2018 WHITE EAGLE WEBELOS/ARROW OF LIGHT OVERNIGHT CAMP LOWDEN

The Scout overnight that follows day camp is an experience for ALL Webelos and Arrow of Light Scouts with an adult partner age 21 or older that is a parent or guardian. Adults are ONLY permitted in the tents with their own Scout. An adult partner can be responsible for up to 2 Scouts. In the event a Scout is not the adult partner's child, other tent/sleeping arrangements must be made.

Following day camp on Friday afternoon, the Webelos/Arrow of Light Scout and his adult partner will begin the overnighter. Campsites will be assigned on Friday afternoon following camp. No reservations will be made. Each Scout/adult is responsible for their own camping gear and Friday evening supper and Saturday morning breakfast. The Webelos/Arrow of Light Overnight will include evening activities. Details to follow upon registration. If you are participating only in the Webelos/Arrow of Light Overnight and not day camp, you MUST still have a health form filled out and turned-in with the pack registration.

☐ Meals – Please bring your own plates and eating utensils as they will NOT be provided. You provide your own Friday night meal and Saturday breakfast, so please come prepared if you plan to cook.

☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
☐ Personal hygiene supplies
☐ Hat for sun protection
☐ Extra shoes (closed toed) and extra socks
☐ Wagon to transport supplies to and from campsite.
☐ Shovel and pail for fire safety.

You will need to transport your gear either by foot or wagon to your campsite. Please contact the Day Camp Director to make arrangements if there are health concerns traveling to the campsite.
