

Sycamore District (McHenry County) CUB SCOUT DAY CAMP Information Guide – 2019

WHAT IS DAY CAMP?

Day Camp is a fun filled 4 days* of scouting activities, fellowship and outdoor fun. All registered BSA scouts (male & female) and invited to join other scouts of their same rank to participate in the fun. Tiger camp is ONE day.

Scouts will have the opportunities to engage in group settings, meet other scouts from various packs, play games, make crafts, participate in shooting sports (archery & BB guns) and create life long memories.



WHEN/WHERE IS IT HELD?

Sycamore District Day Camp is held at the McHenry Township Park located at 3703 N. Richmond Rd. Johnsburg IL.

KIDDIE KORRAL

Kiddie Korral is available for the non-scout children of adult volunteers (staff or den guide) on day(s) the adult is working in camp. Children must be potty-trained. Parents will pick up their children during lunch time and eat with their children.

There is a \$3 per child, per day fee. This fee covers the cost of insurance and program supplies.

SIGN UP/REGISTRATION

Please register your scout according to his/her rank in the <u>fall of 2019</u>. Your Pack Day Camp Coordinator can collect your registration forms and fees. Online registration will be available soon.

Registrations must be completed no later than May 1, 2019. Late registrations are subject to a 10 fee. Late fees are waived for scouts who are new to Scouting or their Pack.

Cost for Day Camp is \$55 per scout. Tiger camp is \$10.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

We're able to keep day camp prices low for all families only because we have a 100% volunteer staff. Each Pack that sends scouts is asked to provide 1 adult staff volunteer for every 5 scouts. Volunteers can help in a Variety of ways; all volunteers are required to have a current Youth Protection Training certificate and attend one camp specific training meeting. All volunteers need to bring Parts A & B of the Annual Health and Medical Record.

Boy Scout age youth, both male and female, are invited to join as Jr. Staff members. Young Adult volunteers help make camp fabulous for our cub scout age campers. Jr. Staffers must be at least age 14.

WHAT TO BRING

- Sack Lunch (refrigeration not required)
- Shatter-resistant refillable water bottle
- Hat (for sun protection)
- Raingear
- Sunblock
- Bug Repellent (non-aerosol)
- Small backpack/daypack for personal gear
- All persons must wear closed toed shoes (no sandals or flip flops)
- A great attitude

Please mark all items with scout's name and pack number.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- · Weapons of any kind
- Toys or collectibles
- Electronic devices
- Expensive personal items

Sycamore District and Blackhawk Area Council will not be responsible for stolen, lost or damaged items. For safety and security, leave these items at home.

HEALTH FORMS AND SPECIAL INFORMATION

All Day Camps have a Medical Officer in camp while campers are present. <u>All persons</u> in camp must have Parts A & B of the Annual Health and Medical record on file for the duration of camp.

Medications, both prescription and nonprescription, must be checked in with the camp Medical Officer and remain in the First Aid area. For the safety of our campers and staff, all medications need to be in their original containers and clearly marked with the scout's name and Pack number.
