- 1. SUPPLY A UNIT INFORMATION SHEET
- 2. HAVE UP TO DATE BEASCOUT.ORG PIN INFORMATION
- 3. MEET WITH CHARTERED ORGANIZATION REPRESENTATIVE.
- 4. PROMOTE "JUST ASK 1" TO ALL CURRENT SCOUTS & PARENTS
- 5. PLACE YARD SIGNS AROUND THE

COMMUNITY

- 6. HAVE AN IN-PERSON SIGN-UP
- 7. COORDINATE AN IN-PERSON YOUTH

Unit's Winning play 100 SWEEP RIGHT, GREAT SIGN-UP NIGHT!

UNITS CAN QUALIFY FOR INCENTIVES! COMPLETE 9 RECRUITMENT PLAYS (7 REQUIRED + 2 OPTIONAL)

- 75%* UNIT GROWTH OF NEW SCOUTS = UNITS EARN AN ICE CREAM PARTY FOR THE UNIT

OR

- 100%* UNIT GROWTH OF NEW SCOUTS = UNITS EARN A PIZZA PARTY FOR THE UNIT

* BASED ON NUMBER OF YOUTH THAT RECHARTERED

BLACKHAWK AREA COUNCIL WILL RECOGNIZE UNITS WHO COMPLETE ALL RECRUITMENT PLAYS (FIRST 7 + 2 ADDITIONAL) IN THE PLAYBOOK AND GROW THEIR UNIT BY 75% FOR A UNIT ICE CREAM PARTY OR 100% FOR A UNIT PIZZA PARTY (FOR EXAMPLE: IF A UNIT RECHARTERED WITH 15 SCOUTS THEN THE UNIT NEEDS TO RECRUIT 15 SCOUTS TO GROW 100%)





#4 Meet with Chartered Organization Representative

IN MANY CASES THE CHARTERED ORGANIZATION HAS THE ABILITY TO PROMOTE TO THEIR YOUTH MEMBERS. HAVING THIS MEETING IS A GREAT START FOR YOUR RECRUITMENT.

- **DURING THE MEETING:**
- ASK TO CONDUCT A YOUTH TALK WITH THE MEMBERSHIP
- REQUEST FLYERS BE PRESENT AROUND THE ESTABLISHMENT
- ESTABLISH A DATE FOR A RECRUITMENT AT THEIR FACILITY
- ASK TO PLACE SCOUTING PROMOTIONS IN THEIR NEWSLETTERS / WEBSITE

#5 Place yard signs around the community

BLACKHAWK AREA COUNCIL WILL PROVIDE YARD SIGNS FOR UNITS TO TELL THEIR COMMUNITY ABOUT UPCOMING SIGN-UP NIGHTS/EVENTS.

#6 Coordinate an in-person youth talk

WORK WITH THE DISTRICT PROFESSIONAL TO SCHEDULE A YOUTH TALK TO PROMOTE YOUR SIGN-UP NIGHT / EVENT. THESE CAN BE HELD AT A SCHOOL OR OTHER LOCATION.

#7 Have an in-person sign-up night / event

A. @ SCHOOL (PREFERRED) OR OTHER LOCATION

B. PROMOTE YOUR RECRUTMENT AT A BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT / MEET THE TEACHER

E. CHURCH

Choose 2 more recruitment plays!

Wear Scout Uniforms to school

SCOUTS IN THE UNIT PICK A DAY TO WEAR THEIR UNIFORMS TO SCHOOL TO PROMOTE THE UNIT'S SIGN-UP NIGHT / EVENT.

Be visible at local events

UNITS CAN SET UP BOOTHS, OR PROGRAM AREAS, AT LOCAL EVENTS DISPLAYING SCOUTING AND PROVIDING AN OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL TO JOIN IN.

LOCATIONS CAN INCLUDE:

- FAIRS
- SPORTING EVENTS
- PARADES
- FARMER'S MARKET
- AND OTHER EVENTS IN THE COMMUNITY

SCHOOL PAGES — UNITS CAN POST EVENTS ON THE LOCAL SCHOOL'S PAGES TO ENSURE EVERYONE KNOWS THEY ARE WELCOME TO JOIN SCOUTING

LOCAL PAGES — MANY TOWNS, OR NEIGHBORHOODS, HAVE LOCAL PAGES THAT UNITS CAN SHARE DETAILS OF THEIR EVENTS

BLACKHAWK AREA COUNCIL COACH'S CORNER

- •Print flyers Once a sign-up night has been scheduled units may request flyers through their District Professional (quantities determined by school population). Blackhawk Area Council will print two rounds of flyers with sign-up night / event details to be distributed 10/14 days prior to the event and again the week of the event.
- •Deliver flyers The District Professional will deliver the two rounds of flyers to the school (10-14 days prior and the week of the sign-up night).
- •Provide yard signs Blackhawk Area Council will provide yard signs to units for display in the community.
- •Provide promotional materials Upon request Blackhawk Area Council can provide additional promotional materials to help your unit grow. Items may include:
 - o Digital-media (videos)
 - o "Just Ask 1" invites
- •Patch incentive A recruiter patch will be provided to every youth who recruits a new scout.

BLACKHAWK AREA COUNCIL COACH'S CORNER

- ·Assist with community outreach Where necessary, your District Professional may contact school officials, chartered organizations, and others in the community to help setup sign-up nights / events.
- •Organize "fun" or Sample Scouting Days Blackhawk Area Council will schedule day activities around the council providing a sampling of scouting where units can invite potential members to join in on the fun. Dates, locations, and promotional materials will be provided by the council.
- •Recruitment tool-kit Blackhawk Area Council will provide kits comprised of: applications, sign-in sheets, an much more!
- •Social Media promotion Blackhawk Area Council will support unit's recruitment efforts with social media posts demonstrating the fun and value of Scouting!
- •School Talk Conduct / Support The District Professional will help schedule and conduct a school talk to grow excitement for the unit's sign-up night / event. In the event that there is no school access a video can be provided for the school to share with their students. Please provide at least 3 weeks notice to the District Professional before the sign-up night / event for the unit's video request.

BLACKHAWK AREA COUNCIL COACH'S CORNER CONT...

- •Press releases Blackhawk Area Council will support unit's recruitment efforts with press releases of upcoming Scouting and joining opportunities. Contact your District Professional for a press release.
- ·Unit incentives* Blackhawk Area Council will provide
 - A Unit ice cream party for 75% unit growth (for example: If a unit rechartered with 15 scouts then the unit needs to recruit 12 scouts to grow 75%)
 - A Unit pizza party for 100% unit growth (for example: If a unit rechartered with 15 scouts then the unit needs to recruit 15 scouts to grow 100%)
- •Council Service Center Blackhawk Area Council will provide 2 council service centers (Rockford & Crystal Lake) ready to assist units with professional and support staff.
- •Scout Shops Blackhawk Area Council will provide 2 Nationally ran Scout Shops (Rockford & Crystal Lake) ready to help new members gear up for Scouting.
- •Website Equipment Locker-Room Blackhawk Area Council provide a web based toolkit with resources to help units grow. (flyer request / unit info sheet/ ask invites/ recruiter form /etc.....)

*Units are eligible for incentives provided they have completed all seven plays + 2 additional of their choosing.
